Residential 50/50 Tree Replacement Application

The City of Lexington's 50/50 Tree Planting Program is being re-established. This program is to assist in the replacement of trees. It allows the home owner to select the species of tree to be planted, helping to diversify and restore the urban forest with all of its ecological and beautification benefits. Homeowners may purchase a shade tree from the list of tree varieties offered at \$75 per tree, with the city paying the remaining cost. Trees will be 2" in caliper.

Applications and payments may be made until noon on April 22, 2022 at the Lexington City Hall. [Payment must be in the form of a check.]

The City will deliver the trees the week of May 2nd and will dig the holes; planting will be finished by designated youth organizations. The home owner will assume all subsequent care of the tree.
