

Meeting of the Police Committee of the Lexington City Council

The meeting of the Police Committee of the Lexington City Council was called to order at 6:35 PM by Police Committee Chairman Hank Brill.

Roll call was taken finding the following present: Alderman Brill, Alderman Miller, Alderman Fiero, Police Chief Dave Schneider and Mayor John Mohr. .

The meeting agenda was posted and indicated intentions to review police department business.

The agenda for the meeting:

1. Police Chief Coverage – Discussed Dave’s coverage that included some split shifts to provide coverage at other times. He felt this change to schedule provided other coverage so there was not a “routine” of just covering the same hours.
2. Update on Part Time union negotiations – A meeting was held with the attorney and the Union. Some issues were agreed. The next meeting has not been Scheduled
3. Update on use of Part Time officers – Currently four of the six part time offices on the roster are being used.
4. Memory Lane – Discussion was related to the possibility of Memory Lane being opened. If it is decide to be opened it could be patrolled. It was suggested it not be opened at night because there is no lighting.
